Hancock County Sheriff Scott Bentzinger reports the following arrests for the week of March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021 through March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021

- 03/08/21 Melissa J Scott, age 39, of Nauvoo, IL was arrested on a Hancock County Warrant charging her with Failure to Appear / Failure to Pay on original charges of No Valid Driver's License. Scott was released after posting the required bond and given a future court date.
- 03/09/21 John A Neally, age 64, of Carthage, IL was arrested and charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Neally was released after posting the required bond and given a future court date.
